<p>RE</p>	<p>Families and Celebrations - Pupils will explore what it means to be a member of a family and why families are important, how we can all love one another. This being their home family, school family and church family (family of God). We will look at Jesus's family and understand that God is also our father in heaven, and why babies receive the Sacrament of Baptism.</p> <p>Keywords - Family, belong, community, celebrations, Church family, Baptism, Symbol, water, oil, Godparents, Priest.</p>	<p>H A L F T E R M</p>	<p>Following Jesus - Explore the symbolism and stories behind the build up to Easter. Children will learn about how Jesus chose some of his disciples and reflect on how we choose our friends. Children will learn about Mother's Day and the importance of our Mothers and Jesus' Mother Mary. Children will learn the story of the Good Samaritan – they will reflect on the message it has for us as the followers of Jesus. Children will learn about The Easter Story and what happened on Good Friday.</p> <p>Key words- Disciples, friends, Jerusalem, praying, The Good Samaritan, Hosanna, Good Friday, Crucifixion, Easter.</p>

Addition and Subtraction - Read write and interpret mathematical statements including addition, subtraction and equal signs. Number bonds to 20. Missing number problems. Geometry- Properties of shapes - Recognising shapes, including 3D. Multiplication and Division - Understanding through grouping and sharing. Measurement - mass of weight (e.g. heavy/light) and begin to record.</p>		<p>Busy Ants Maths Units 7/8 Collins workbook 1B Continue with Addition and Subtraction Measurement (time) - sequence events in chronological order, dates including days of the week, months etc. Tell the time to the hour and half past the hour, drawing hands on the clock face. Continue with Number and Place value - Recognising numbers to 100. Fractions - Half and quarters. Measurement - (volume and capacity) full/empty, more than/less than and begin to record.</p>
